

The following rules and guidelines are being provided to not only ensure that everyone understands what is expected from a Region III member, but to allow us as an Association to make your rodeo experience the “Best” it can possibly be.

STATE MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS (HS & JR HIGH)

1. **BOTH PARENTS AND REGION III MEMBER MUST SIGN FRONT AND BACK OF THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION (RODEO SECRETARY IS A NOTARY)**
2. **MEMBER’S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER MUST BE PROVIDED**
3. **PREVIOUS YEAR’S FINAL REPORT CARD MUST BE PROVIDED**
4. **MEMBER MUST PROVIDE A COPY OF THEIR BIRTH CERTIFICATE (RETURNING MEMBERS, YOUR BIRTH CERTIFICATES ARE ON FILE)**
5. **CURRENT COGGINS**

****INCOMPLETE PACKETS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE UNTIL ALL DOCUMENTS ARE ON FILE****

REGION III RULES AND GUIDELINES

Saturday events begin at 8:00 a.m., if you are in the rough stock events this means we are bucking the 1st horse at 8:00 a.m. not setting up gear or stretching but ready to nod at 8:00 a.m.-Sharp. Sunday events begin at 9:00 a.m. (after Church Service)

Judges sheets will be posted one hour before the rodeo begins with the draw and contestant order. Be sure to verify when you are up because if you are called three times and not ready you will be considered at Turn Out and we will move to the next contestant.

Dress Code will be enforced at all times **inside** the rodeo arena. This applies to **EVERYONE** i.e.: Contestants, Volunteers and Parents

All deadlines will be enforced-No Exceptions.

If the postmark is after the deadline date you must pay the \$30 late fee before competing. If Dodge Tickets, State Ads, Region Ads and Semester Report cards are not received by the established deadline you can not compete. (These deadlines are listed on every entry form and our website thsra3.com)

A pre-entry basket can be found at the entry office and you are encouraged to enter the next event by utilizing this system. Fill out the appropriate entry form, circle the rodeo you are entering and attach your payment and put in the basket. Bank deposits are made the Tuesday **following** the event so that if a contestant needs to draw out they can call on the Monday night Call-In and not be penalized. After Monday night entries will not be altered and fees stay in to pot. Entries in the basket without the payment attached are incomplete and therefore will be charged the \$30 late fee.

Call-In entries are the Monday prior to the event from 6:30pm – 9:30pm at (817)706-8236---After this time entries will not be accepted.

SLACK OPTION:
