- 1) All contestants must bring either their final report card for the 2024-25 school year, transcript for the 2024-25 school year, or a letter from their school (on school stationary, with school seal) listing their Spring Semester Grades or a letter stating that the contestant has passed at least 70% of subjects taken for the 2nd semester (not year end grades). The letter must be signed by a school counselor, principal or superintendent. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO CHECK IN WITHOUT ONE OF THESE DOCUMENTS. NO ONE WILL BE ABLE TO HAVE GRADES FAXED AFTER 1:00 PM SUNDAY, JUNE 8th this will be when check-in is over.
- 2) Any contestant having a problem making the check-in time on Sunday, June 8th, needs to call this office (936)590-4447 ASAP. The only excuse for being late to check-in has to be school related.
- 3) Campers and/or horses cannot be brought in and left on grounds or in stalls before Wednesday morning, June 4th, 2025, starting at 8:00 AM for the cutting and Reined Cow Horse contestants or Friday, June 6th, 2025, for the remaining finals' contestants. 


